Fox Leader Courses Ages 13-15

At age 12, children are starting to transition into walking the path of becoming a young adult. Whilst they still enjoy playing, it is important to offer this age group the choice of being a camper, or a course which develops the skills needed to enter the world of employment. At age

Skills Gained with The Fox Leader Role:

- Confidence.
- Problem solving.
- Self-awareness.
- Adaptability.
- Relationship building.
- Time management.
- Decision making.
- Critical thinking.
- Conflict resolution.
- How to have social and active fun!!!

Our Fox Leaders often have completed at least one year of Secondary School and the week is designed to give an insight into what is involved in working at Forbesy Camps and the childcare industry.

Fox Leaders both shadow and observe staff and can be matched with activities in which they have a particular interest, as well as be free to join the session. The Fox Leaders course will cover and include the following areas during the week (the five days can be booked across several camps – please contact Kellie on 07717582184 to find out how):

What Your Child Is Rewarded With:

1. Daily appraisal and training with the Camp Manager/Welfare Manager in:
 - A. **Monday** – Safeguarding.
 - B. **Tuesday** – Health and Safety.
 - C. **Wednesday** – Fire Safety.
 - D. **Thursday** – Mini First Aid.
 - E. **Friday** – Camp Operations.
2. A Certification of Youth Leadership Skills which will look great on their CV. (This will be a recognised certification – we are just working on something with Ofsted!)
3. **FREE** Black Fox Leader T-shirt if a full 5-day week is booked.
 - A. If you are only booking days, then you can purchase a black Fox Leader T-shirt at cost price of £15 to wear to camp. Go to blue tile “Camp Extras – Great Dunmow and Springfield”. Book payment for first day of camp, and the size will be sorted at registration.
4. Feel a part of the team and stand at the front with the staff at registration.
5. Be given a walkie talkie once they demonstrate the first stages of leadership.
6. Auto entry “Fox Leader of The Week” prize of a £20 Amazon voucher.
7. AND ... A foot in the door to become an assistant Den Captain!

Once qualified, further days can be booked on camp at **£25 Per day** (Age 12-14). 15-year-olds may attend for free on a work experience basis. This can lead to vouchers being sent to parents as a reward for their participation 😊 We can also spread the five-day course across weeks in the summer holidays; please message Kellie: 07717582184
