



Suitability and Safety of Premises and Equipment

- The health and safety of your child is taken very seriously and we will do all that is reasonable and practicable to protect the health, safety and welfare of all children in our care, alongside staff.
- We have formalised systems of proactive and reactive checks and assessments to keep the equipment, sessions and children safe at all times.
- Camp staff check that all premises and equipment are suitable and safe for activities on a daily basis.
- During sessions, gates are locked and staff are vigilant to ensure that children are unable to leave unless accompanied by a member of staff or a parent. In addition, no- one can enter the relevant premises without staff knowledge.
- At the start and end of days staff ensure that children are supervised in car parks and/or where car are parked. All children aged eight or under are fully supervised at these times.
