We run an exceptional Early Years programme, from age 3–5, where your children are cared for by our Level 3 plus staff, who have extensive experience of working with this age group at schools and/or nurseries.

Balance of learning & fun

We appreciate they are not at school and are on their school holidays — so we attentively ensure your children attain a wonderful balance of education and just pure fun!

Patient, loving care

Our staff are here to patiently and lovingly care for your children, with their welfare, safety and mental/physical development at the heart of the fun daily schedule planned for them.

Energy-aware activities

Camp can be active at times, but our team are trained to observe energy levels and deliver activities to suit their needs at any time.

Siblings together

If they have an older sibling at the school, they are allowed to join the Early Years group with them.

Aspiration through friendship. We believe the development of our Early Years is sometimes about aspirations — so under the watchful care of the Early Years Team, we let the little cubs interact with some of the older children, who love to help the little ones.

A warm welcome on day one. On arrival your children are given a name badge and taken to the Early Years Manager and team to learn where everything is and what their day entails. Then — they'll have the 'Best Day Ever!'

Our Early Years team are made up of qualified Level 3 plus staff, with one staff member per 8 children. Our ratios are:

Additional members are usually training to be a teacher.

Our Promise to Your Family

We are one of very few camps (if any) that give every age group a choice of active or craft in every single session. It's their holiday too — and giving them choice really empowers them.

What to Bring

- ✓ Comfortable clothes & trainers

Handy Tips

Label **everything** with your child's name — especially lunchboxes and water bottles.

Avoid nuts and nut products in packed lunches. **We have a strict NO NUTS policy.**

We use camp sunscreen, but pack a sunscreen if you prefer your child to use their own.

If your child takes regular medication, complete a medical form on iPal and tell staff at drop-off.

Health & Safety in Early Years

The little details that keep our littlest cubs healthy, happy and cared for:

- ✓ EYs always wash hands before eating.
- ✓ Always accompanied when going to the toilet.
- ✓ Always reminded about healthy eating, brushing teeth and drinking water during lunch break.
- ✓ Always seated still during eating time, listening to staff so they can concentrate on eating.
- ✓ We weave numeracy and early literacy into activities whenever possible — introducing numbers and the alphabet in fun, engaging ways.
- ✓ A strict "no nuts and seeds" policy.
- ✓ Their "tuck shop" is a fruit sweet, to help limit sugary treats.
- ✓ One biscuit is given as a treat in the afternoon break, from Forbesy Camps.
- ✓ We have a "no kissing" policy — but cuddles and love are given freely if the children want or need them.
- ✓ Lap cuddles are allowed if a child is distressed.

Welfare at the heart of everything. Our pre-school and young reception children enjoy a balance of active fun and restful fun — always with a watchful, loving eye on their wellbeing.
